Thank you for considering Kelmscott Senior High School for your child's high school education.

Kelmscott Senior High School is a school of opportunity for students. The school offers Department of Education endorsed Specialist Programs in Agriculture and Music, Gifted & Talented Secondary Selective Entrance Program and a range of Kelmscott Extension Programs (KEP) in Mathematics, Science, English and Humanities & Social Sciences. We are only one of two schools who provide Gifted & Talented Online to rural areas. Given our broad offerings we attract students from Martin to Mandurah to North Beach.

In addition, the school offers a suite of school based programs in rowing, languages, soccer and athletics to cater for a range of student interests and abilities. All this occurs in excellent facilities with a strong focus on pastoral care.

Please be aware we are unable to consider your enrolment without provision of the following documents:

- Birth Certificate or extract (call 1 300 305 021 if you don't have one) or other identity documents (ie passport)
- Immunisation Certificate (call 1 800 653 809 if you don't have one)
- Copies of Family Court or any other court orders such as Proof of Guardianship (if applicable),
- Proof of Address –
 - Proof of ownership of the property by the parent/s where the student will reside. Three documents need to be provided as evidence and may include a rates notice from the local council, a gas, telephone or other official account that provides proof of residence.
 - Where the family is in a rental property, a copy of the complete rental agreement. The rental agreement must be current at the time the student commences at the school. ***The renting of a room at a property is not acceptable for enrolment.***
- Information relating to suspensions or exclusions (if applicable)
- Information relating to disability (if applicable)
- Copy of most recent school report

If your child was not born in Australia, you must provide evidence of:

- Date of entry into Australia
- Passport or travel documents
- Current Visa subclass and expiry date and previous Visa subclass (if applicable)

If your child is a temporary visa holder, you must also provide:

- Confirmation of enrolment or evidence of any permission to transfer provided by Education & Training International (ETI) at study.eti@dtwd.wa.gov.au (if holding an International Visa, sub class 571); or
- Evidence of the visa for which the student has applied if the student holds a bridging visa
