## This selection sheet should be completed after reading the 'Guide to Year 10 Studies'

- All students will study the five core courses (as listed as Compulsory)
- All students are also required to study either General Physical Education or a specialist unit from H&PE, such as Athletics or Soccer.
- If students wish to undertake further studies in Physical Education, they may choose additional elective courses.
- All other learning area courses are subject to student/family selection.
- All courses (compulsory and elective) are year-long. It is not possible to change electives mid-year
- Course charges are listed as a guide. The specific charges for each student will be calculated and sent to families prior to 1 December.
- Should students change their mind about their selected courses – they will be able to apply for a change in December this year or within the first two weeks of the school year starting. Any requests to change course will be subject to availability.

## When selecting Elective Courses:

- Students are required to select **ONE** subject from each of these lines as their first preference and write it in the box labelled 'First'. Then choose **ONE** reserve subject (your second choice) from each of the lines and write in the box labelled 'Reserve'.
- General Physical Education is **COMPULSORY**. Students must select General Physical Education on **ONE** line.
- Specialist subjects (Athletics, Agriculture and Soccer) are for students who have been selected into the program. They are studied four sessions per week.
- Please **DO NOT** select First preference as Reserve on alternative lines.
- The School will endeavour to allocate your top three preferences first, before using your reserve choices
- If you currently study Specialist Agriculture, Specialist Music, Soccer or Specialist Athletics choose this course as your first preference.
  - where these courses are offered as a double elective (four periods per week instead of two) it course will count as two electives

- I understand that in order for my child to study these courses, I must pay any compulsory charges for those courses or my child may be withdrawn from the practical aspects of that course.
